**North Central District Health Department regretfully announces a new death from Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One hundred-twenty-nine new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 4606. Eighty-eight individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** – Shelby County has had another COVID-19 related death in an adult Caucasian female with pre-existing underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has one hundred-twenty-nine cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

North Central District released eighty-eight individuals from isolation; seventy-eight from Shelby County, eight from Spencer County, and two from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
