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North Central District Health Department is reporting seventy-seven new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 4803. Fifty-six individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has seventy-seven cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

Note: North Central District Health Department will not issue a press release on Friday, December 25, 2020 in observance of Christmas Holiday; the release on Monday, December 28, 2020 will contain the COVID-19 numbers from Thursday thru Sunday.

North Central District released fifty-six individuals from isolation; one from Shelby County, sixteen from Spencer County, twenty-five from Henry County and fourteen from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
