North Central District Health Department is reporting one hundred-seventy-eight new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 4981. Two hundred-sixty-three individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has one hundred-seventy-eight cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

Note: North Central District Health Department did not issue a press release on December 25, 2020, in observance of the Christmas holiday. As a result, today's (12/28/20) press release will contain the COVID-19 numbers from Thursday to Monday.

Note: North Central District Health Department will not issue a press release on December 30, 2020 and January 1, 2020, in observance of the New Year's Holiday; the release on Monday, January 4, 2020 will contain the COVID-19 numbers from Tuesday thru Sunday.

North Central District released two hundred-sixty-three individuals from isolation; one hundred-sixty-seven from Shelby County, thirty-nine from Spencer County, thirty-one from Henry County and twenty-six from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
