North Central District Health Department regrettably announces a new death from Henry County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One hundred-sixty new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 3814. One hundred-four individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Henry County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian male with pre-existing underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has one hundred-sixty cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

North Central District released one hundred-four individuals from isolation; sixty-five from Shelby County, twenty-two from Spencer County, ten from Trimble County, and seven from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“In November, we more than doubled the number of Covid-19 cases that occurred in our counties from October's cases. If this trajectory continues, we could reach nearly 10,000 cases in the District by the month-end of February. The result of inaction from the community will overwhelm the healthcare system, continued economic hardship for our communities, and more deaths among our friends and families. Now is the time that we must take action to prevent this grim outlook by avoiding family gatherings, including small groups, diligently wearing face coverings, proper handwashing, and maintain social distancing.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.
