North Central District Health Department regretfully announces a new death from Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One hundred new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 3914. Fifty-eight individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian male with pre-existing underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has one hundred cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 3 pediatric Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released fifty-eight individuals from isolation; twenty-one from Shelby County, four from Spencer County, twenty-eight from Trimble County, and five from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“Health officials are predicting a spike in Covid-19 cases; due to the lack of recommended compliance during the Thanksgiving holiday. The community needs to take action to prevent the further spread of this virus by masking up, maintain social distance, and getting tested to identify those who need to self-isolate to protect the community health at large.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.

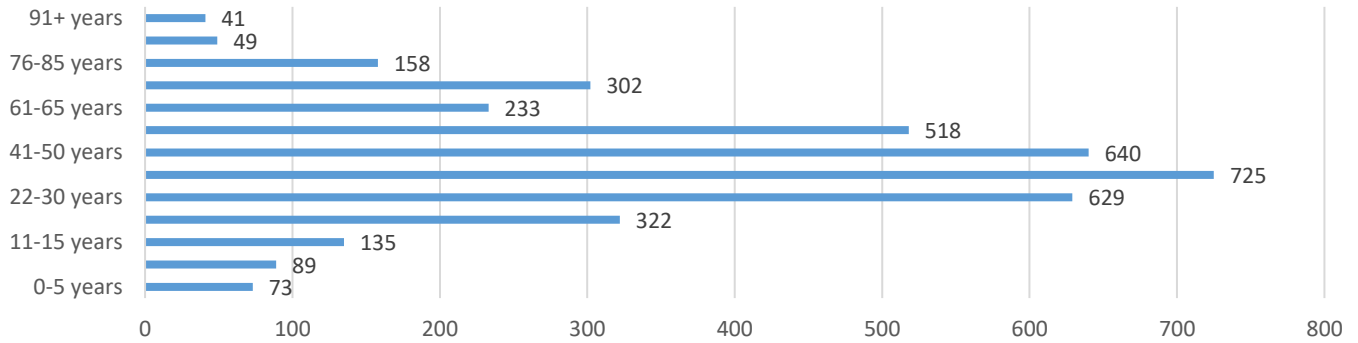

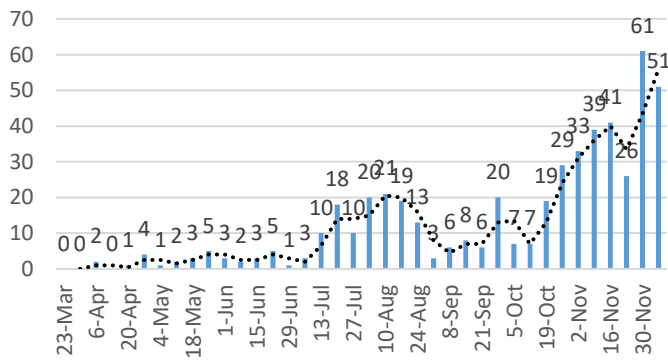

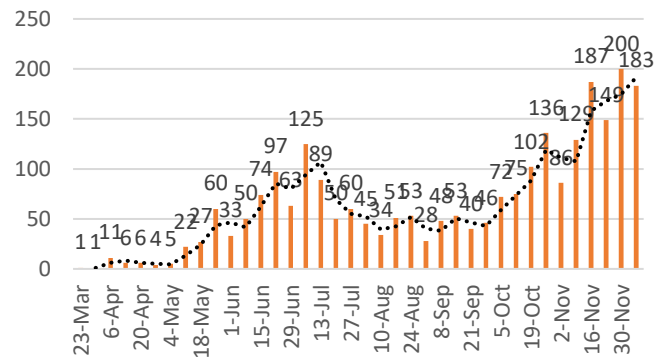
North Central District Cases by Age as of 12/07/2020



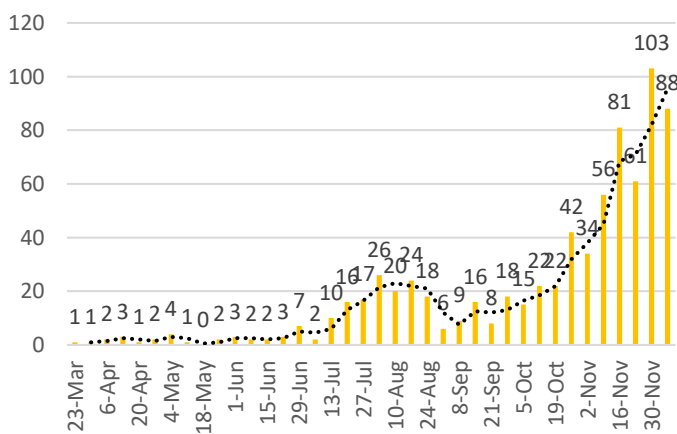
Henry County Cases by Week
