North Central District Health Department is reporting two hundred twenty-nine new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 6824. One hundred fifty-two individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has two hundred twenty-nine cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

North Central District released one hundred fifty-two individuals from isolation; seventy-seven from Shelby County, thirty-seven from Spencer County, twenty-six from Henry County and twelve from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

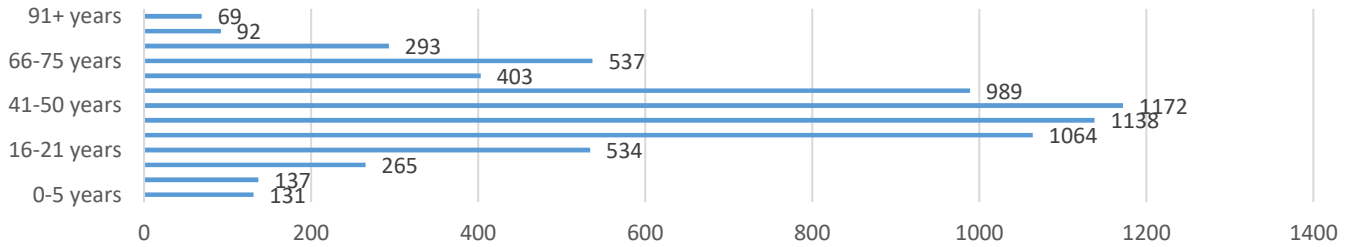

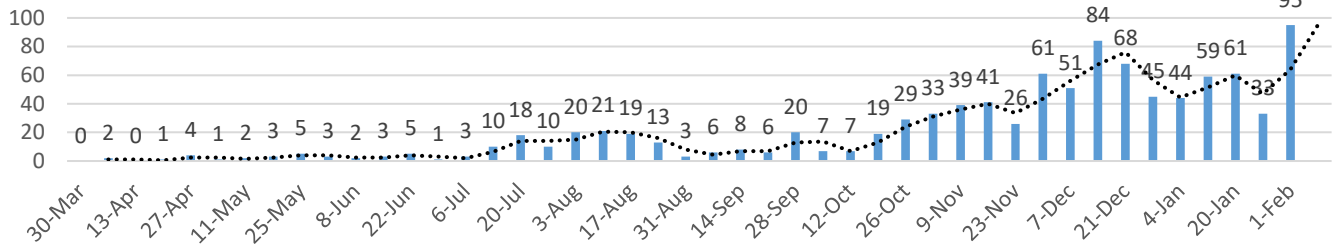

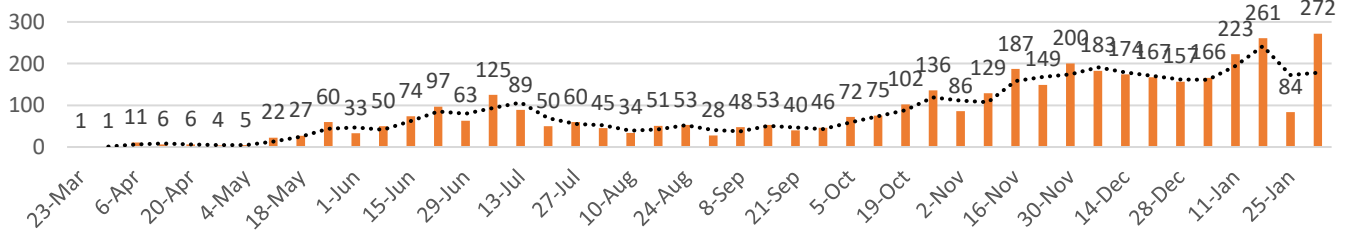
North Central District Cases by Age as of 02/01/2021



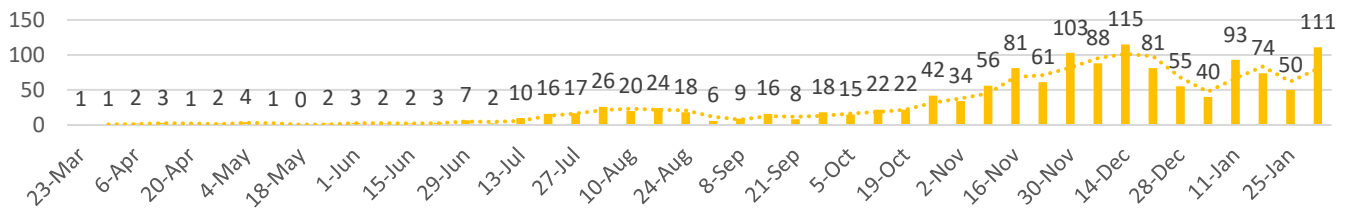
Henry County Cases by Week
