North Central District Health Department regretfully is announcing another death in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Sixty-six new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 7,480. Fifty-four monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian female with underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has sixty-six cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 31**
 - 9 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 15 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 pediatric Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 pediatric Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Hispanic females in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 7**
 - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 elderly Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 24**
 - 8 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 11 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 pediatric Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric African American female in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 4**
 - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released fifty-four individuals from isolation; twenty-two from Shelby County, eighteen from Spencer County, eight from Henry County and six from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

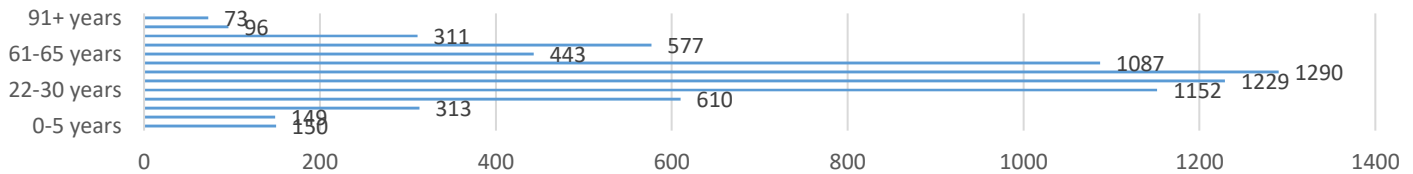

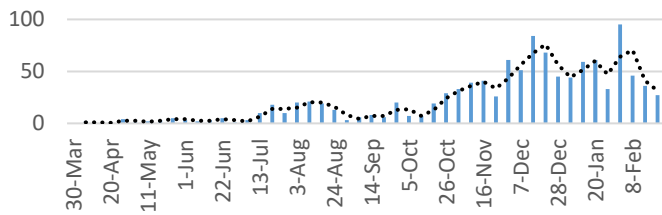

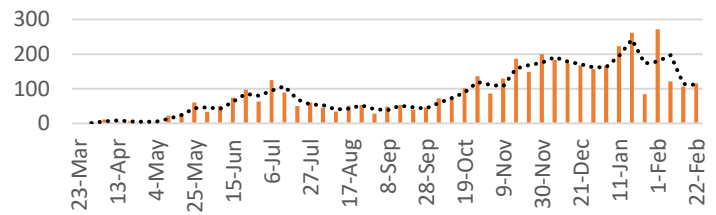
North Central District Cases by Age as of 02/22/2021



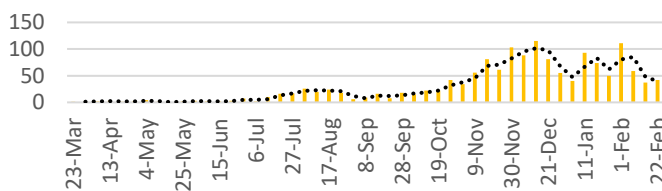
Henry County Cases by Week
