North Central District Health Department is reporting ninety-three new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 6995. Sixty-six monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has ninety-three cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 10 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 17 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 elderly Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.

- **Spencer County= 25**

 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.

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North Central District released sixty-six individuals from isolation; thirty-one from Shelby County, eighteen from Spencer County, fourteen from Henry County and three from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
