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North Central District Health Department is reporting ninety new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 5768. One hundred ninety individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has ninety cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

North Central District released one hundred ninety individuals from isolation; one hundred twelve from Shelby County, thirty-one from Spencer County, thirty-one from Henry County and sixteen from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
