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North Central District Health Department is reporting one hundred thirty-seven new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 5905. One hundred thirteen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has one hundred thirty-seven cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

Note: North Central District Health Department will not issue a press release on January 18, 2021, in observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. National Holiday. As a result, the press release on Wednesday, January 20, 2021, will contain the COVID-19 numbers from Saturday-Wednesday.
