**North Central District Health Department regrettably announces two new deaths from Shelby County and one new death from Henry County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Two hundred fifteen new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 6120. Two hundred seventeen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** –Shelby County has had two new COVID-19 related deaths in elderly Caucasian male, and in an elderly Caucasian female with pre-existing underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to their families and friends.

Henry County has had a new COVID-19 related death in elderly Caucasian male with pre-existing underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has two hundred fifteen cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

**Note:** North Central District Health Department did not issue a press release on January 18, 2021, in observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. National Holiday. As a result, today's (1/20/2021) press release will contain the COVID-19 numbers from Saturday to Tuesday.
