North Central District Health Department is reporting seventy-seven new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 6197. One hundred individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has seventy-seven cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).
