**North Central District Health Department regrettably announces twelve new deaths from Shelby County, two new deaths from Spencer County, and one new death from Trimble County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Two hundred-seventy-six new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 5257. Two hundred-forty-four individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

## **Shelby County, KY –**

North Central District Health Department has two hundred-seventy-six cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

North Central District released two hundred-forty-four individuals from isolation; ninety from Shelby County, sixty-three from Spencer County, fifty-three from Henry County and thirty-eight from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

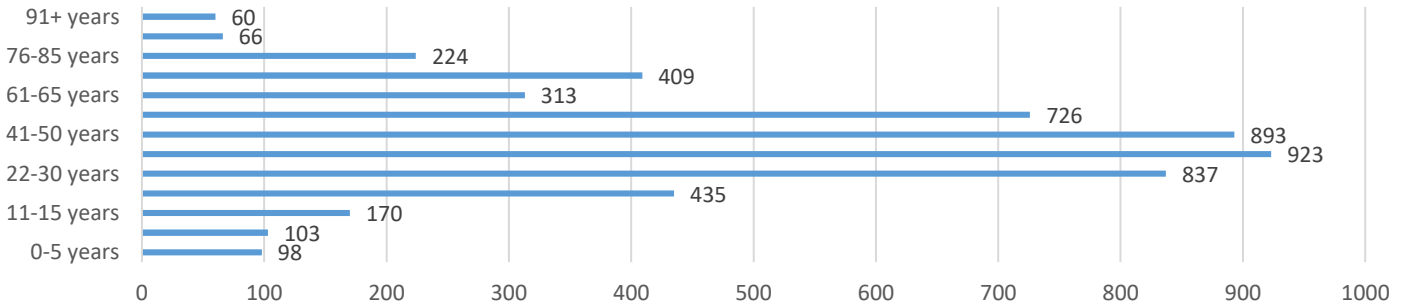

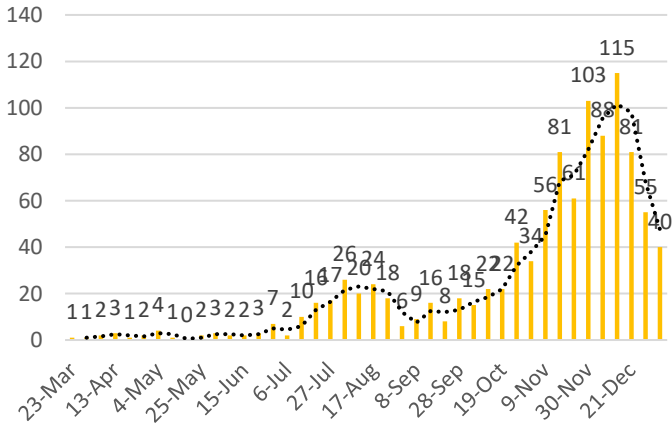

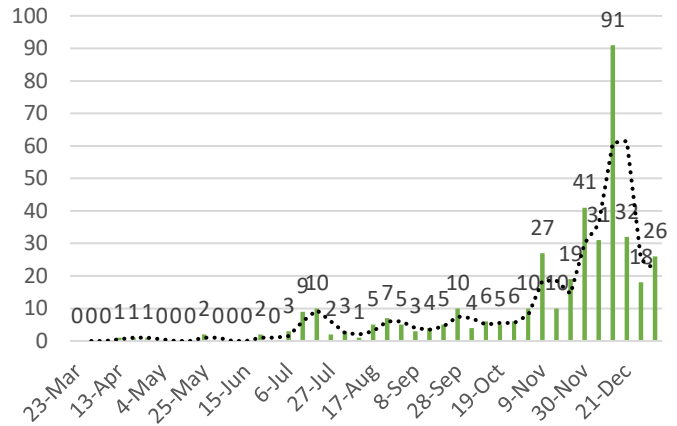
### North Central District Cases by Age as of 01/04/2021



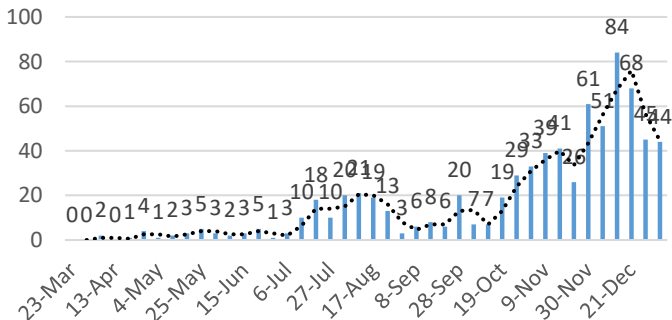
### Spencer County Cases by Week



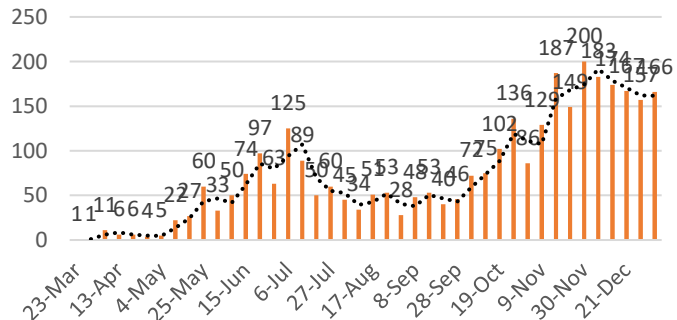
### Trimble County Cases by Week
