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North Central District Health Department is reporting one hundred-ninety-four new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 5451. One hundred-seventy-five individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has one hundred-ninety-four cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 2 elderly Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released one hundred-seventy-five individuals from isolation; one hundred-fifteen from Shelby County, twenty-six from Spencer County, twenty-one from Henry County and thirteen from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
