North Central District Health Department regretfully is announcing one death in Henry County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Twenty-one new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 8,574. Thirty-two individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Henry County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian female with underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has twenty-one cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 8**
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult African American male in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 pediatric African American females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric African American male in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 6**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female under medical care.
- **Henry County= 4**
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric African American female in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 3**
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 African American female in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released thirty-two individuals from isolation; seventeen from Shelby County, eleven from Spencer County, two from Trimble County, and two from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

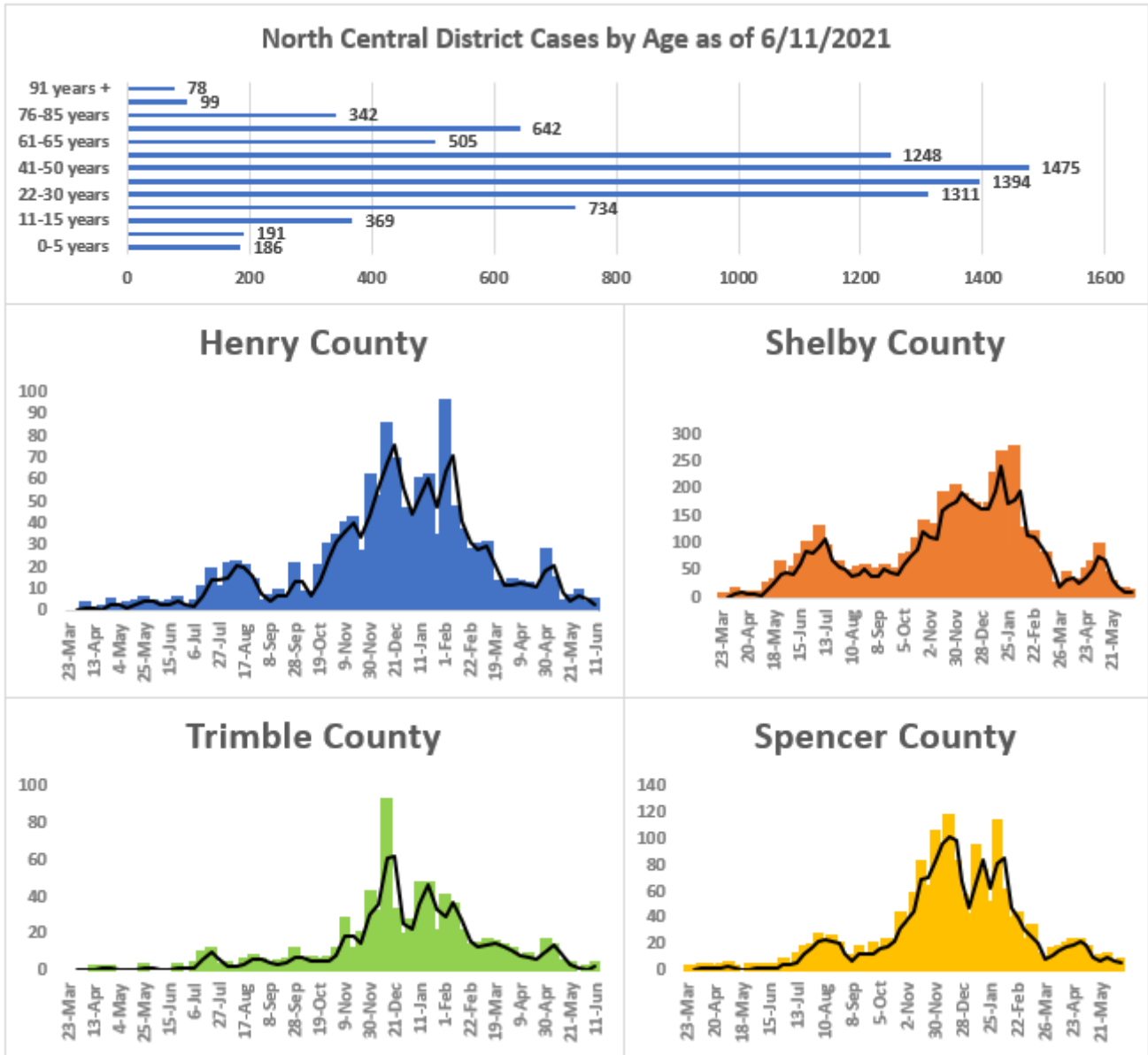
