**North Central District Health Department is reporting sixteen new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 8,590. Nineteen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** – North Central District Health Department has sixteen cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 6**
  - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult unknown male in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 6**
  - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 1**
  - 1 adult unknown male in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 3**
  - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released nineteen individuals from isolation; eleven from Shelby County, two from Spencer County, two from Trimble County, and four from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

*“I am happy to report that with only 16 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 for this reporting period, the cases are on a downward trajectory. Henry and Shelby County both have vaccination rates greater than 40 percent. Trimble County's vaccination rate is near 30 percent. While Spencer County shows a lower percentage rate, at 18 percent of the population vaccinated, it appears that there may be some limitations within the KYIR dataset that may not be painting an accurate picture of the true vaccination rate in Spencer County. We feel the COVID vaccination rate may actually be much higher in Spencer County than is being reflected in the data. NCDHD is working closely with the Kentucky Department for Public Health regarding the data limitations so that the vaccination rate of Spencer County can be reflected accurately. It is important that we continue to work together as a community to encourage COVID vaccination on our journey to reaching herd immunity and officially ending the pandemic.”, Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.*

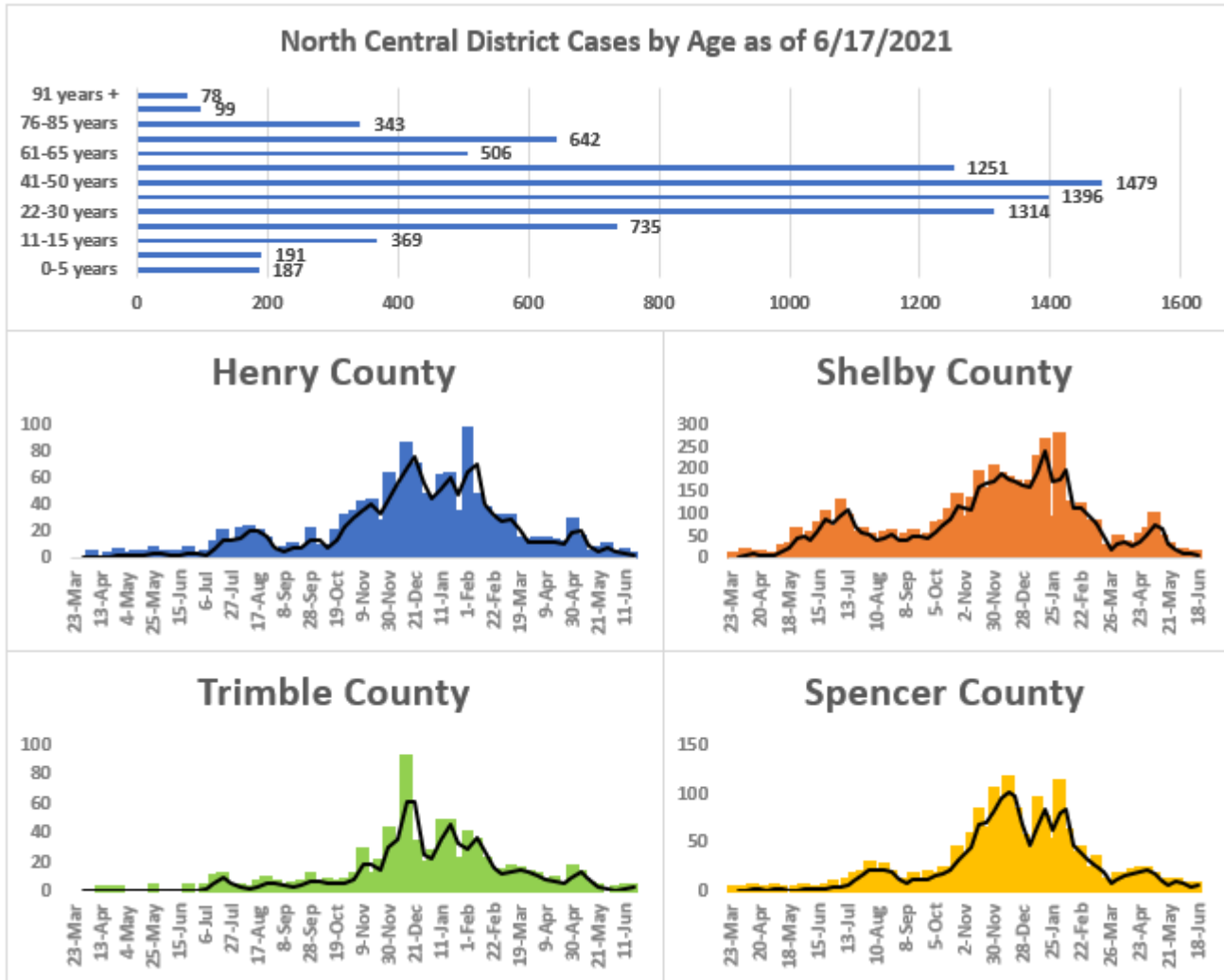
