**North Central District Health Department will be changing a few aspects of how Covid-19 cases are reported, where the case information is obtained, and more Covid-19 related information.**

**Shelby County, KY** – As accessibility to timely data imports improves, North Central District Health Department will be shifting the weekly COVID-19 to reflect what is reported on state and federal resources. Case counts will now be pulled from the State REDCap (Research Electronic Data Capture) reporting system so that we have the most up-to-date information. These Case Counts reflect investigations that meet confirmatory and probable case definition as defined by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). As we transition to utilizing these new data sets, there will be some fluctuation with numbers in various categories. Additionally, this report is a living document and as such, the data are subject to change.

This initial shift in the numbers is due to the transition from using North Central District's internal numbers to the REDCap state reports (*Total Cases: 55 less; Henry: 93 More; Shelby: 55 Less; Spencer: 56 Less; Trimble: 37 Less*). Going forward, this report is updated regularly, so as cases are reviewed and reconciled, those updates will be reflected in our weekly numbers. While this is a more accurate report of our numbers and consistent with what the State is using for reporting, it is a living document and is subject to change. Also, although there are no new deaths to report this week, you will notice there are 3 fewer deaths in Shelby County. This is because there were 3 deaths that were reviewed by the death review committee and determined NOT a COVID-19 death.

North Central District will no longer be offering Covid-19 testing at our local clinics since an abundance of locations in our district is available that offer this testing.

North Central District will be changing the format of our press releases, in hopes to streamline the process and ease of viewing for our community members. Also, we will no longer send out press releases to the community and the media, but the information will be available via our website and our social media outlets. Those interested in this information should go to these sites to view COVID 19 case related information. Due to the upcoming July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday, new COVID 19 related case information will be posted on Tuesday, 7/6/21.

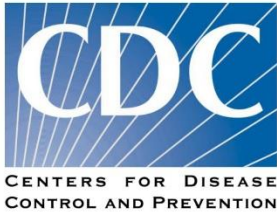

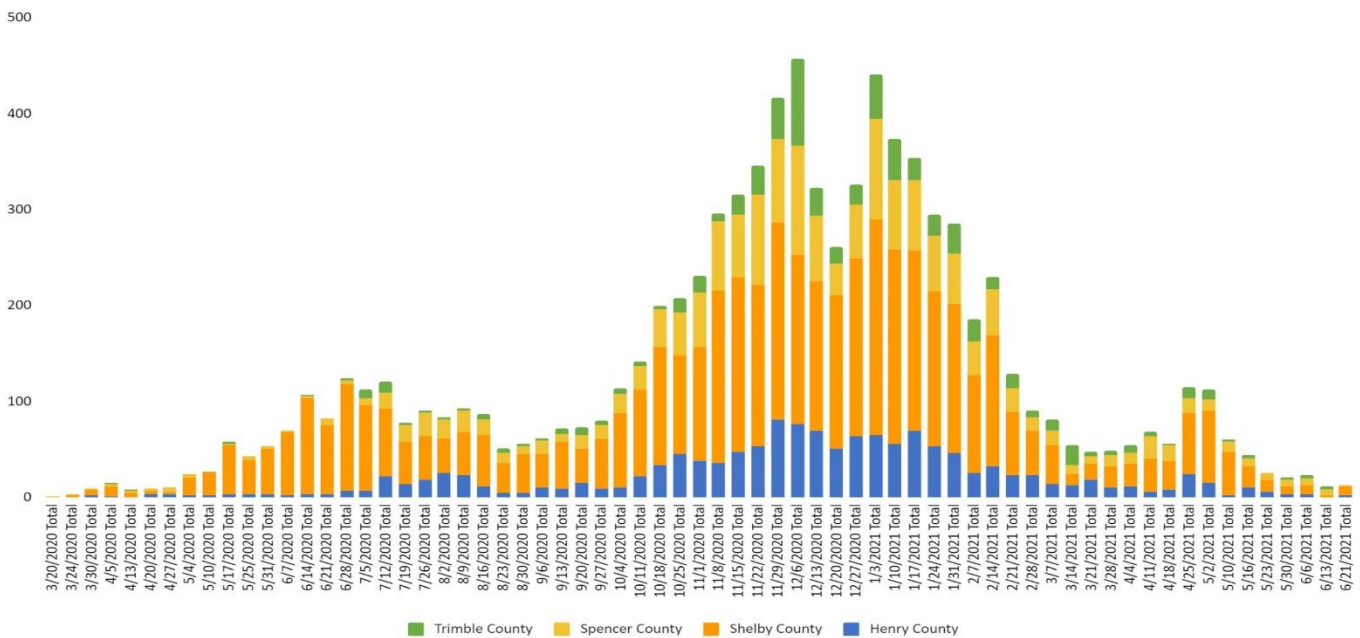
