**North Central District Health Department is reporting thirty-six new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 7,619. Forty-eight monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** – North Central District Health Department has thirty-six cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 17**
  - 9 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 elderly Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 7**
  - 5 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 7**
  - 4 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 5**
  - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released forty-eight individuals from isolation; thirty-two from Shelby County, eight from Spencer County, six from Henry County and two from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

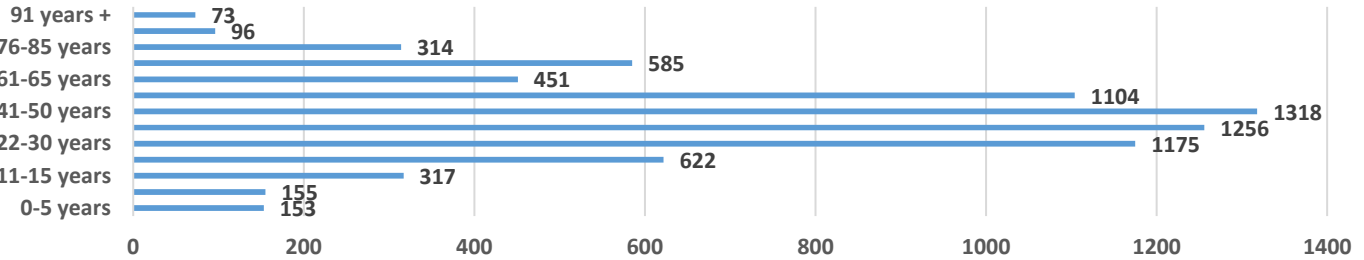

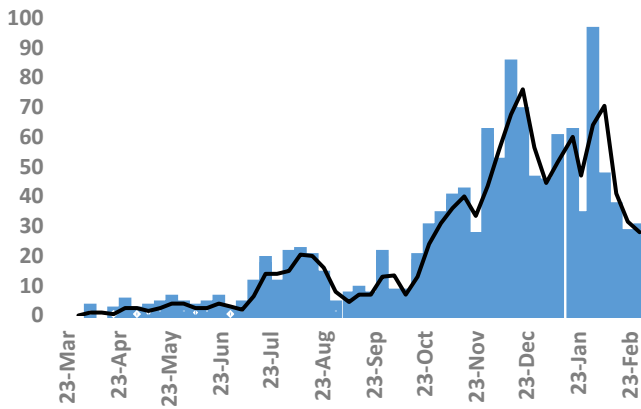

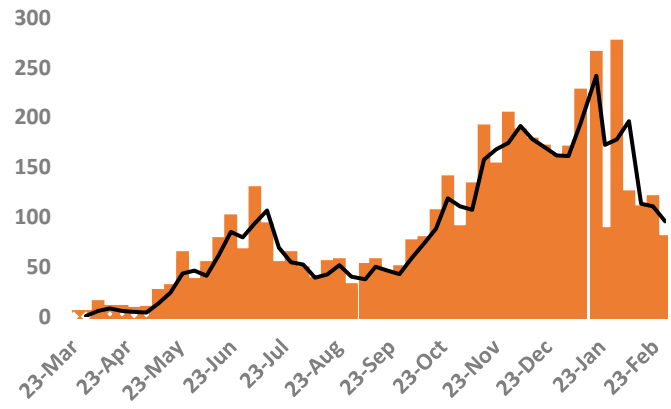
## North Central District Cases by Age as of 3/1/2021



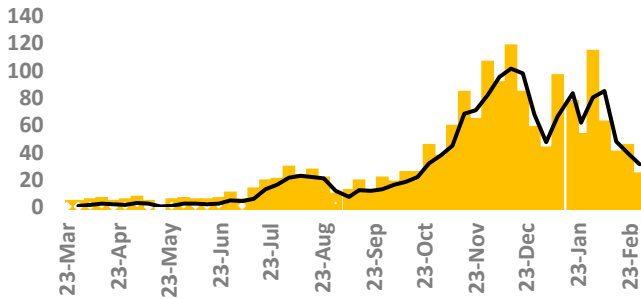
## Henry County Cases 3/1



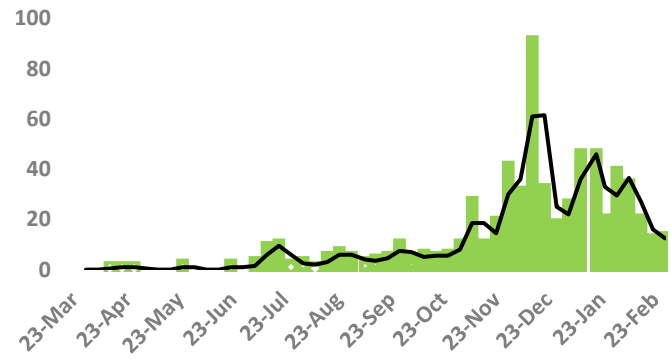
## Shelby County Cases 3/1
