North Central District Health Department regretfully is announcing another death in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Eighteen new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 7,664. Twenty-one monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly African American male with underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has eighteen cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 6**
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric African American male in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 2**
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 10**
 - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 elderly Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released twenty-one individuals from isolation; five from Shelby County, five from Spencer County, seven from Henry County and four from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
