North Central District Health Department regretfully is announcing a new death in Spencer County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One hundred-thirty-five new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Spencer, and Trimble Counties, increasing the district case count to 8,406. One hundred-twenty individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Spencer County has had a COVID-19 related death in an adult Caucasian male with underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has one hundred-thirty-five cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released one hundred-twenty individuals from isolation; sixty-five from Shelby County, seventeen from Spencer County, twenty-four from Henry County and fourteen from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

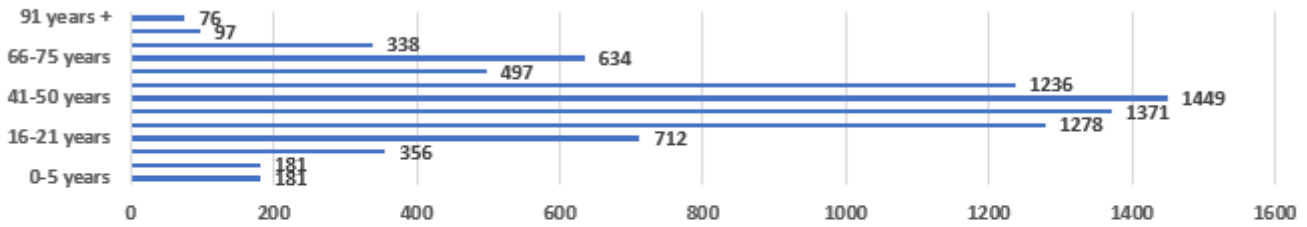

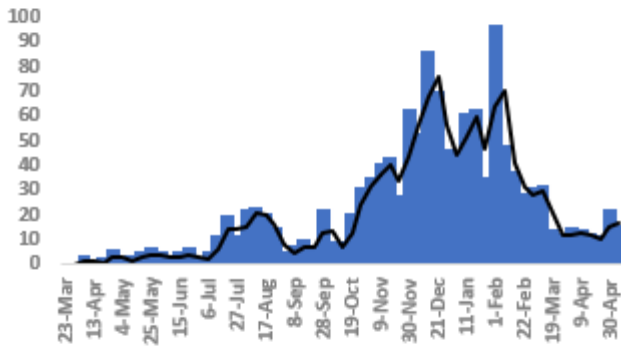

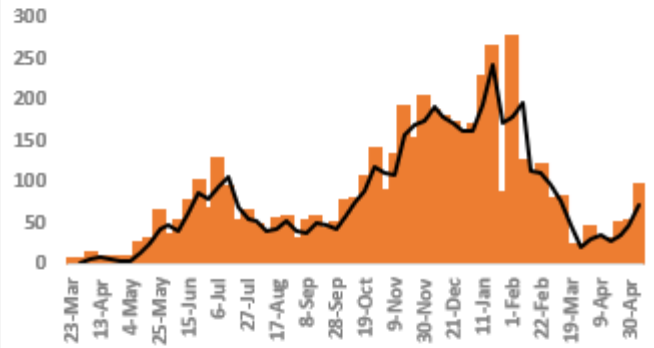
North Central District Cases by Age as of 5/7/2021



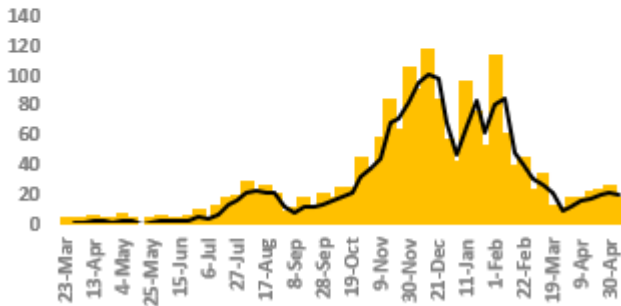
Henry County
