**North Central District Health Department is reporting two hundred-fifteen new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 2797. One hundred-sixty-six individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** –North Central District Health Department has two hundred-fifteen cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

\*Note: North Central District Health Department did not issue a press release on 11/11/2020, in observance of Veterans Day. As a result, today's (11/13/2020) press release will contain the COVID-19 numbers from Tuesday to Friday.

North Central District released one hundred-sixty six individuals from isolation; ninety-one from Shelby County, twenty-eight from Spencer County, fifteen from Trimble County, and thirty-two from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
