North Central District Health Department regrettably announces two deaths, one in Henry County and one in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Ninety-five new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 2996. Fifty-six individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian female with pre-existing underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

Henry County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian male; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has ninety-five cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 10 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 elderly Caucasian females under medical care.
 - 4 pediatric Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

- **Trimble County= 5**
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released fifty-six individuals from isolation; thirty-four from Shelby County, fifteen from Spencer County, one from Trimble County, and six from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“According to the CDC and the latest scientifically reviewed data, ‘cloth face coverings are one of the most powerful weapons we have to slow and stop the spread’ of the COVID-19 virus. Also, the personal use of a face covering not only prevents spread from an individual but protects the individual who is using the face covering.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.
