North Central District Health Department has received two new lab confirmed cases in Shelby County, one case in Henry County, and one case in Spencer county increasing the district case count to 19.

Shelby County, KY – two patients from Shelby County have tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19); an adult male is under medical care and adult female currently in self-isolation at home. One new case in Henry County an adult female in self-isolation at home and on new case in Spencer County an adult female in self-isolation at home.

One case that was noted in Shelby County last week was a false positive due to lab reporting error, the new numbers below reflect the change.

“With steadily increasing number of cases and the beautiful weather forecasted, it is imperative that everyone participate in social distancing and stay home if you can. If we do not, the number of cases will only continue to grow.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
