North Central District Health Department has received two new lab confirmed cases one in Shelby County and one case in Spencer County increasing the district case count to 25.

Shelby County, KY – One patient from Shelby County has tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19); an adult male currently under medical care and one new case in Spencer County an adult female is in self-isolation at home.

“When going out to get essential supplies and food, please remember to limit the trip to one person per family, so we can reduce the number of people in stores and reduce potential exposures to the virus. Please remember how important social distancing is and practice it.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
