North Central District Health Department has one new lab-confirmed case, in Spencer County increasing the district case count to 29. Two individuals from Shelby County released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has received a new case, an adult female from Spencer County who has tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) is currently in self-isolation at home. Two patients from Shelby County have been released from isolation by monitoring their symptoms and complying with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
