**North Central District Health Department is reporting 15 have recovered from COVID-19, releasing 11 COVID-19 cases from isolation.**

Shelby County, KY – North Central District is pleased to report 15 individuals have recovered from COVID-19 out of the 26 cases in our district. Releasing 11 isolation cases; two (2) from Henry County, seven (7) from Shelby, two (2) from Spencer County. These patients been released from isolation by monitoring their symptoms and complying with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“When going out to get essential supplies and food, please remember to limit the trip to one person per family, so we can reduce the number of people in stores and reduce potential exposures to the virus. Please remember how important social distancing is and practice it.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
